

Kanab Community Behavioral Health services (ABA or mental health) Scholarship Program

Helping Families Cover Out-of-Pocket Medical Costs

Program Overview: The Kanab Community Behavioral Health services (ABA or mental health) Scholarship Program is designed to assist local families who are facing significant out-of-pocket medical expenses that are not covered by insurance. Our goal is to ease the financial burden for families who are struggling to meet their deductibles and medical expenses, while ensuring that they continue to receive the care they need.

Program Benefits:

- **50% Coverage:** The scholarship will cover 50% of your medical deductible until your insurance kicks in and covers 100% of your eligible medical expenses.
- Payment Plan for Remaining Balance: For the remaining 40-50% of the deductible, we
 will work with you to set up a reasonable payment plan, with monthly installments that fit
 your budget over the course of a year.
- **Annual Renewal:** The scholarship can be renewed annually, as long as the family continues to meet the eligibility requirements and demonstrates financial need.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Residency: Applicants must reside within 30 miles of Kanab or the surrounding areas.
- **Insurance Requirement:** You **MUST** have active health insurance coverage, but you are facing a deductible or out-of-pocket costs that are a financial hardship.
- **Financial Need:** Applicants must demonstrate financial need through a brief application process that includes income verification and medical cost documentation.
- Pending review of your application.
- At least 15 hours a week of services for 1 year.

How to Apply:

- 1. **Complete the Application:** Fill out the scholarship application form available at crimsonheightsbh.com/kanab-scholarship.
- 2. **Provide Documentation:** Submit proof of income, a recent medical bill showing your deductible, and any additional information requested.
- 3. **Review and Approval:** Once your application is submitted, our team will review it and notify you of the approval and the scholarship amount. If approved, we will discuss payment options for the remaining balance.
- 4. **Renewal Process:** If your situation changes and you need continued support in subsequent years, we will ask you to submit a renewal application annually.



Payment Plans: We understand that medical bills can be a heavy burden, which is why we strive to offer flexible payment terms. For the portion of the deductible not covered by the scholarship (40-50%), we will work with each family to create a manageable monthly payment plan. Payments will be spread out over a year, but we can adjust the terms as necessary based on your individual circumstances.
